2019 Veterans' Benefits Pursuant to MGL c 115 and CMR 5.0

You *may* be eligible for Veterans' Benefits from the Massachusetts Department of Veterans' Services, if:

You are a veteran with an honorable discharge and/or the spouse or widow/widower of a veteran (you are not covered if you are divorced or legally separated from the veteran.)

and

Your Total Monthly Income **is less than:**

- Single Person: \$2,023.00
- Married Couple (combined income): \$2,743.00

Total monthly income includes income from any of the following resources:

- Social Security
- Social Security Disability Insurance (SSDI)
- Annuities
- VA Compensation from Pension or Disability
- Other pensions and retirement benefits
- Worker's Compensation
- Unemployment Benefits
- Wages or Tips

Total cash asset limits (savings, stocks, IRA, 401K, bonds, etc.*) must be less than:

- Single Person: \$5,000
- Married Couple: \$9,800

Total assets do not include your primary residence or auto.

Note: dependent children, under the age of 19, may also qualify.
