Renewal of Second Class Motor Vehicle Sales License by Cambridge Road Auto Service, dba Woburn Plaza Shell, 293 Cambridge Road: Chairman Higgins said there is a condition that “no banner or flag-type displays shall be permitted on the site.” Motion made by Alderman Concannon and seconded by Alderman Gately that the license renewal “ought to pass,” with the existing condition; approved, 5-0.

Renewal of Second Class Motor Vehicle Sales License, Capelo’s Auto Service, dba J.C. Auto Sales, 84-86 Winn St.: Chairman Higgins said there is a limit of 12 vehicles on the license. Motion made by Alderman Concannon and seconded by Alderman Gately that the license renewal “ought to pass,” with the existing condition; approved, 5-0.

Renewal of Second Class Motor Vehicle Sales License, Capelo’s Auto Service, dba Capelo’s Auto Sales, 22 Winn St.: Chairman Higgins said there is a limit of 15 vehicles, the license is specifically limited to the 22 Winn St. location, and the license is non-transferable. Motion made by Alderman Concannon and seconded by Alderman Gately that the license renewal “ought to pass,” with the existing conditions; approved, 5-0.

Renewal of Second Class Motor Vehicle Sales License by Murray’s Enterprises, Inc. dba Murray’s Auto & Truck Sales, 88 Winn St.: Chairman Higgins said there is a limit of five vehicles and the conditions are consistent with the special permit approved for the business. Motion made by Alderman Concannon and seconded by Alderman Gately that the license renewal “ought to pass,” with the existing conditions; approved, 5-0.

Motion made to adjourn by Alderman Gately and seconded by Alderman Mercer-Bruen; approved, 5-0. Chairman Higgins adjourned the meeting at 6:25 p.m.
