Woburn Bowladrome Inc., 32 Montvale Avenue, for renewal of bowling alley license:

Chairman Higgins noted the application has not been signed by the applicant. Motion made by Alderman Mercer-Bruen and seconded by Alderman Concannon that the license renewal “ought to pass;” pending the signature on the application; approved, 4-0.

Moura Dijar dba ABCE Taxi of Woburn, 165M New Boston Street, Suite 241, for renewal of taxi cab license: Chairman Higgins said there have been no issues with the applicant. Motion made by Alderman Mercer-Bruen and seconded by Alderman Concannon that the license “ought to pass” with any existing conditions; approved, 4-0.

Gevorg Melikyan dba Milano Jewelry, 494B Main Street, for renewal of License to Purchase and Sell Second-Hand and Personal Articles of Value and Collectibles: Chairman Higgins said she has spoken to Det. James Flynn of the Woburn Police Dept. and he said there have been no problems associated with the business. Motion made by Alderman Mercer-Bruen and seconded by Alderman Gately that the license renewal “ought to pass,” with any existing conditions; approved, 4-0.

M&L Transit Systems Inc., 60 Olympia Avenue, Suite 1, for renewal of common carrier license: Chairman Higgins said there is a limit of three vehicles. Alderman Gately asked if there was a fire at that address. Alderman Mercer-Bruen replied there was a fire at another business in the area that does not have a flammable license and she spoke to Building Commissioner Quinn on Friday about the fire and he is working on it. She said the business where the fire occurred has no connection to the applicant and there is no reason to detain the license renewal. Motion made by Alderman Mercer-Bruen and seconded by Alderman Concannon that the license renewal be sent “back for action;” approved, 5-0.

Motion made to adjourn by Alderman Gately and seconded by Alderman Concannon; approved, 4-0. Chairman Higgins adjourned the meeting at 6:13 p.m.
