On the appointment of Joseph A. DiMatteo, 1 Revere Road, to the Woburn Golf & Ski Authority for a term to expire to expire Dec. 31, 2023: Mr. DiMatteo said it is a busy time at the Woburn Country Club but overall things are going well. He said he was just re-elected Secretary and Treasurer of the WG&SA. Mr. DiMatteo said he has not missed a meeting since he was appointed to the authority. Mr. DiMatteo said he chaired a selection committee for the new golf pro. Alderman Gaffney, who is the Council's Liaison to the authority, said Mr. DiMatteo does a great job as a member of the WG&SA. Alderman Concannon concurred he has heard nothing but positive comments about Mr. DiMatteo's work on the authority. Alderman Gately said he has heard good reports about Mr. DiMatteo but added one of the WG&SA members recently did a number on Ronald Martignetti, an abutting property owner. Alderman Gately said the criticism of Mr. Martignetti was uncalled for and it's not the way the city ought to be doing business. Alderman Gately acknowledged Mr. DiMatteo played no role in the criticism of Mr. Martignetti, who he said asked for help because golf balls were blasting off his building. Alderman Gately asked if the WG&SA has had trouble obtaining a quorum for its meetings. Mr. DiMatteo said there used to be problems obtaining a quorum but there have been a few new members who have attending the meetings regularly. Alderman Gately reiterated what went on with Mr. Martignetti is unacceptable. Motion made by Alderman Anderson and seconded by Alderman Concannon that the appointment "ought to pass;" approved, 3-0. President Haggerty told Mr. DiMatteo his appointment will be confirmed at the City Council's next meeting on Tuesday, April 3, and there is no need for him to attend.

Motion made by Alderman Concannon and seconded by Alderman Anderson to adjourn; approved, 3-0. Chairman Campbell adjourned the meeting at 6:03 p.m.
