On the order to transfer \$222,341 from Fire/BLS Ambulance account to Fire Ambulance account:

Appearing for the Woburn Fire Dept. was Chief Stephen Adgate, who reported the money in the transfer will be used for the purchase of a new front-line ambulance. Adgate noted 72-percent of the fire department's operations consist of emergency medical services and the new ambulance will allow the department to continue to service the needs of the residents of Woburn. Adgate said the current Rescue 3 ambulance has more than 100,000 miles and will be traded in as part of the purchase of the new ambulance. The cost of the ambulance itself is \$196,491, and the remainder of the transfer will be used to outfit the new ambulance with supplies. Adgate said he hopes to have the new ambulance on the road in September. Motion was made and seconded the transfer "ought to pass" and approved, 5-0.

The Finance Committee meeting was convened at 6 p.m. and was adjourned by Alderman Concannon at 6:05 p.m.
