On the petition from West Woburn Development Corp. regarding the dimensions of the water pump station at Winning Farm: Appearing for the petitioner was attorney Joseph Tarby, who said condition #1 of the special permit originally issued in 2003 and modified in January 2017 incorporated a water pump station that on the version of the landscape plans was measured at 16-feet by 24-feet, when the actual size of the water pumping station is 17-feet by 27-feet. Attorney Tarby asked for a determination from the committee that the pump station is in substantial conformity with the plans that were approved in 2017. Chairman Gately said he has no problem with confirming the 2017 plans. Motion made by Alderman Gaffney and seconded by Alderman Tedesco to accept the version of the plans from 2017 denoting the size of the water pumping station as 17-feet by 27-feet; approved, 5-0. Motion made by Alderman Tedesco and seconded by Alderman Mercer-Bruen to adjourn the meeting; approved, 5-0. Chairman Gately adjourned the meeting at 6:43 p.m.
