**Petition for renewal of Livery License from Roman Limousine:** Representing the petitioner was Iuliano Tacu, President, Roman Limousine. Chairman Higgins said there is an issue with the application because it lists the address of the business in Peabody. She said the vehicle registrations indicate five vehicles are registered in Peabody and two others are out-of-state. Mr. Tacu said he has an office on Gill Street and he pays taxes in Woburn. Alderman Concannon asked if Mr. Tacu has copies of his excise tax bills. Mr. Tacu said he does not. Motion made by Alderman Mercer-Bruen and seconded by Alderman Concannon to send a communication to Treasurer/Collector Timothy Donovan requesting him to provide the committee with any excise tax bills and receipts associated with Roman Limousine; approved, 4-0. Alderman Concannon said he does not want to further delay the petition, but the council does have a concern about whether the vehicles are registered in Woburn, whether it is a Woburn business, and whether excise taxes are paid to Woburn. Chairman Higgins said the insurance binder lists a business address in Somerville. Mr. Tacu said that is a mailing address. Chairman Higgins said the committee has make sure the business is located in Woburn. Alderman Concannon suggested leaving it in committee until there is proof the business is located in Woburn. Mr. Tacu said he can bring in a lease from Cummings Properties. Alderman Concannon said the committee could opt to send the application out “back for action,” pending receipt of the requested documents. Mr. Tacu said he can bring in the requested documents tomorrow morning. Chairman Higgins suggested sending the petition back for action pending the receipt of the appropriate documents. Motion made by Alderman Mercer-Bruen and seconded by Alderman Concannon to send the matter “back for action” pending the receipt of proof of excise tax payments and a lease document from the city; approved, 4-0.

**Motion made to adjourn by Alderman Mercer-Bruen and seconded by Alderman Concannon;** approved, 4-0. Chairman Higgins adjourned the meeting at 6:07 p.m.
