New Woburn Fire Station Building Committee to Meet on November 28 at City Hall

Mayor Scott Galvin is pleased to announce the formation of The Woburn Fire Station Building Committee, which will hold its first meeting on Wednesday, Nov. 28, 2018, at 4 p.m. in the Engineering Conference Room at City Hall.

The new Woburn Fire Station Building Committee will identify and study possible solutions to upgrade and modernize Woburn Fire Department facilities. The first task for the committee will be to approve a detailed Request for Proposal to hire an architectural firm to conduct a feasibility study for the construction of a new fire station.

The goal of the feasibility study will be to identify facilities appropriate for upgrades, identify potential additions, identify facilities that can be phased out, and identify parcels of land to locate a new, state-of-the-art fire station.

The construction of a new fire station follows department studies, assessments and an evolution of the management team, including the addition of a full-time training officer and deputy chief, as well as investment in critical equipment and resources.

Our Fire Department continues to provide the highest level of quality public safety services to our community, delivered with increased safety to firefighters. It is now time to move forward with our plans to improve critical function and operations of the City's existing fire station buildings, with an eye toward finding the best path and best location for new facilities.
