PUBLIC HEARING

Notice is hereby given that the City of Woburn Conservation Commission will hold a Public Hearing on Thursday, August 20, 2020, at 7:00 P.M. in the City Hall, at which time a Request for an Amendment to the Order of Conditions (DEP #348-766) for work at Battlemarch Village (aka 165 Cambridge Road) filed by Mary Trudeau, on behalf of Scott Seaver of Seaver Construction, under the Wetlands Protection Act, M.G.L. Chapter 131, sec. 40, and the Woburn Wetlands Ordinance, Title VII, will be heard. The change sought is to modify condition number 80 of the Order of Conditions to allow the stream crossing work during flow conditions by use of a temporary flow bypass. The purpose of the Hearing is to take in all information on the proposed change to assist the Commission thereafter in the issuance of an Amended Order of Conditions.
