Pursuant to Title 3, Section 11 of Chapter 172 of the Acts of 1897 of the Legislature of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, as amended, known as the Charter of the City of Woburn, the Assistant City Clerk and Clerk of the City Council Pro Tem called to order the City Council.

Further, pursuant to said Act, the City Council proceeded to the election of a President by roll call vote.

ROLL CALL: Councilor Campbell - Concannon; Councilor Concannon Concannon; Councilor Demers – Concannon; Councilor Dillon - Concannon; Councilor DiMambro – Concannon; Councilor Ferullo - Concannon; Councilor Gately – Concannon; Councilor Mercer-Bruen - Concannon; Councilor Viola – Concannon.

On the first ballot, Councilor Michael P. Concannon received nine (9) votes. Councilor Michael P. Concannon, having received the necessary majority vote, was declared elected to the position of President of the City Council.
