

**Woburn License Commission

Chairman Skeffington convened the meeting of the License Commission at 6:15 p.m.

- 1. Woburn Police Patrolmen’s Association, application for a special 1-day liquor license for a softball tournament at Library Park on Harrison Avenue, on Saturday, September 10, 2022, from 8 a.m.-10 p.m.:** Representing the petitioner was Woburn Police Officer John Donnelly, 25 Harrison Avenue, Woburn, MA. Officer Donnelly said the WPPA is seeking a special 1-day liquor license to serve beer during the annual John Maguire Softball Tournament at Library Park. Capt. Murphy said proceeds from the event go towards scholarships in Officer Maguire’s name. Commissioner Pappalardo asked which teams play in the tournament. Capt. Murphy said there are teams from surrounding cities and towns. He said there will also be games at fields in Burlington, including Marvin Field. He said the tournament is in tribute to Officer Maguire, whose wife Desiree usually attends. Officer Donnelly said the first game is always between teams from the Woburn Fire Dept. and the Woburn Police Dept. Chairman Skeffington said he has attended in the past and there is always good camaraderie between the teams. Motion made by Commissioner Pappalardo and seconded by Commissioner Gilgun to grant the special 1-day license and waive the \$100 application fee; approved, 3-0.
