**MOTION** made by Councilor Viola and seconded by Councilor Dillon to waive the reading of and to approve the minutes of the meeting of December 12, 2022, all in favor, 5-0.

**Petition for new Livery License for Myra Transportation, 200 Bedford Road, Apt. 4F:** Appearing for the petitioner was No Name Given Sidharth, 200 Bedford Road, Apt. 4F, Woburn, MA. Chairman Ferullo said all paperwork is in order. He said Mr. Sidharth is seeking a livery license for one vehicle, a 2019 SUV that will be parked at 200 Bedford Road. Mr. Sidharth said he requires a livery license to pick up and take passengers at Logan Airport, in the limousine lot. Councilor Dillon asked where the vehicle will be parked. Mr. Sidharth said he is allotted two parking spaces at his apartment building and the livery vehicle will occupy one of those space. Councilor Demers said he will support the petition. He said it can be very difficult to find transportation to the airport. He said Massport can be very strict about access to the airport. Motion made by Councilor Demers and seconded by Councilor Campbell that the license renewal “ought to pass;” approved, 5-0.

**Petition for renewal of First Class Motor Vehicles Sales License for Gordon Colonial Inc., dba Colonial Cadillac, 201 Cambridge Road:** Chairman Ferullo said all the paperwork is in order and there are no complaints in the file. Motion made by Councilor Viola and seconded by

Councilor Campbell that the license renewal “ought to pass” with any existing limits or conditions; approved, 5-0.

**Petition for renewal of Second Class Motor Vehicle Sales Licenses by the following:** Anchor Auto Sales, Inc., 3 Breed Avenue; Murray’s Enterprises, Inc. dba Murray’s Auto & Truck Sales, 89 Winn St.; JSFO Auto Sales LLC, 84-86 Winn St.; Enterprise Rent-a-Car Company of Boston LLC, 248 Mishawum road; E&C Auto Brokers LLC, 505 Main St.; McSheffrey’s-SE, LLC dba McSheffrey’s of the South End, 75 Main Street; and Michael R. Celata II, dba Central Automotive, 275 Salem St. Chairman said all the paperwork is in order for each application with the exception of E&C Auto Brokers, which lacks a Certificate of Treasurer/Collector. Motion made by Councilor Viola and seconded by Councilor Campbell that with the exception of E&C Auto Brokers, the license renewals “ought to pass,” with any existing conditions or limits; approved, 5-0. Councilor Demers said there have been reports of excess parking at 505 Main Street, and Building Commissioner Thomas Quinn was sent to investigate. He said he wants to see if the committee can get a determination from Commissioner Quinn. Councilor Dillon said there have been some issues with Murray’s Enterprises and he will check with the neighbors to make sure any problems have been resolved.
